

## 55th Anniversary Observed In The Town Of Holland

The fifty-fifth wedding anniversary of Mr. and Mrs. H. J. Huenink of the town of Holland was observed at their home over the week-end. On Saturday evening a family gathering was held at which the couple's children, uncles and aunts were guests, and on Sunday noon the children and their families, including the 13 grandchildren, were entertained at dinner.

The couple was married in Cedar Grove on May 3, 1887, in the First Presbyterian church, of which they are prominent and active members, Mr. Huenink having been an elder there for many years.

It was at the age of 5 years that Mr. Huenink came to this country with his parents. He was born at Aalten in the Netherlands, on Oct. 15, 1863. As a youth he learned the cheesemaking trade and later farming became his occupation. He was also affiliated with a general store.
